## Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that the removal of trees on Municipal property or Public Reserve is done in a controlled manner that is beneficial to the Municipality and the property owner adjacent to the Municipal property or Public Reserve.

## **Policy Statement**

The Municipality is committed to establish a policy to regulate the removal of trees on Municipal property and Public Reserve.

# Responsibility

Owners of property adjacent to the municipal property that would like to remove a tree from municipal property or Public Reserve are required to submit the following information in a written application prior to the removal of the tree/s.

- Your name, mailing address, telephone number.
- Rationale for the tree removal.

### **Authority**

The first contact should be Municipality of Killarney – Turtle Mountain Council.

### **Implementation Procedures**

- 1. Council has the right to allow or refuse the removal of the requested tree.
- 2. The following reasons will considered for tree removal:
  - a) New or replacement of existing water/sewer lines
  - b) New building and or addition
  - c) Where the tree is causing a safety concern
  - d) Municipal road needs widening to allow for better access.
- The Municipality is responsible for the cost of removal trees that are damaged or diseased.
- 4. The cost of removal will be borne by the person making the request for removal of healthy trees.

- 5. Tree/s removal that is approved by Council prior to removal will not be subject to a charge.
- 6. Tree/s removal prior to Council's permission being granted will be subject to a fine as follows:

1 tree removed \$500.00 2 to 5 trees removed \$1,000.00 5 or an undetermined # of trees removed \$5,000.00
